Studio Meeting – Coordinated, Expert Assistance with Translational Research Proposals, Protocol Design & Support

Due to increasing complexity and advancement in clinical and translational research, investigators often need multi-disciplinary expert advice and assistance as they develop research proposals and design protocols.

To receive this assistance, investigators can schedule a Studio meeting through the ACTSI. The Studio meeting provides access to ACTSI experts in biomedical informatics, biostatistics and/or regulatory, ethical and protocol design support. The **intent** of a Studio is to:

- provide expert advice at the beginning and most effective time in the proposal creation process or protocol design stage
- provide a one-stop venue for investigators in order to standardize support and produce successful grant submissions
- have an investigator understand and be aware of all available resources (using <u>eBIRT</u>) and expertise (<u>iResearchGeorgia</u>) available within the ACTSI

Based on past investigator feedback, Studios provide value by:

- "discussing and brainstorming grant ideas"
- "IT and data management"
- "sample size determination"
- "data management assistance"
- "reassessment of long term needs"
