What is it?

- A 12-month, NIH supported, mentored clinical research program:
 - working in a low- or middle-income country (28 sites in 20 countries)
 - pre- or postdoctoral fellows (MD, PhD, PharmD, etc.)
- Fellowship year typically runs from July-June, with applications due in November

Benefits:

- Stipend, insurance, travel, and research funds, as well as a week-long orientation at the NIH with the world's leading global health experts
- Gain research experience and have the opportunity to publish in scientific journals and present at national and international conferences
- An active network of alumni are available to provide mentoring support
