

Fast Grants – Fast Funding for COVID-19 Science

Science funding mechanisms are too slow in normal times and may be much too slow during the COVID-19 pandemic. Fast Grants are an effort to correct this. If you are a scientist at an academic institution currently working on a COVID-19 related project and in need of funding, we invite you to apply for a Fast Grant. **Fast Grants are \$10k to \$500k and decisions are made in under 14 days.** If we approve the grant, you'll receive payment as quickly as your university can receive it. We require that a Fast Grant be used solely to expedite COVID-19 related science. Beyond that, the grant recipient has complete discretion over how it's spent.

Eligibility

You must be:

- A PI at an academic institution
- Already working on a project that could help with COVID-19 pandemic **within the next six months;**
- In need of additional funding to complete the project.

How to Apply

COVID-19 Fast grants Application form must be completed via Google docs. You will need sign in with a Gmail account to access the form.

The form requests that you complete the standard questions which includes the following: Email address, Name, Institution, Role, Link to your Google Scholar profile, Your top three published papers, PhD Year, Project impact, Work to date, Data/draft figures from COVID-19 work, are you cleared by your University to work in a lab, Target completion, Dollars requested and short justification, Other Funding.

What Conditions Apply?

- You must use the grant to work on COVID-19 related science.
- For six months, you must send us monthly updates, summarizing your progress. These updates can be as simple as a single-paragraph email.
- You must upload all manuscripts reporting work supported by the grant to a preprint server such as a bioRxiv or arXiv upon submission to a peer-reviewed journal.
- In line with Gates Foundation policy, will pay at most 10% in overhead costs to the University.
