Who can participate?

What are the categories?

Abstracts will be subject to the same scientific review as for any national or regional meeting. The scientific content of poster presentations should reflect one of the following categories:

- **Drug Discovery and Development**
- **Food and Nutrition**
- **Healthcare IT**
- **Industrial Production**
- **Medical Technology and Devices**

- **Nanotechnology**

What if my Abstract gets selected?

For student, post-doctoral or non-profit organization abstracts selected, the corresponding author of each poster will receive complimentary registration to the Summit. In addition, posters submitted by students will be eligible for a limited number of poster awards. If your Abstract is selected, you will be required to attend the Summit on Poster Session Day on Friday, October 8, 2021 for judging.
