CALL FOR ABSTRACTS: PRECISION ONE HEALTH CONFERENCE 2024

<u>Eligibility:</u> Only graduate students and postdoctoral associates are eligible to submit an abstract. We encourage submissions that align with the conference's theme, "One Science at the Intersection of Patients, Animals, and our Environment," and contribute to the advancement of precision medicine across species and ecosystems. <u>Abstract Requirements:</u> Abstracts should be no longer than 250 words and must be structured using the following sections:

- 1. <u>Title:</u> Clearly and concisely state the focus of the research.
- 2. <u>Background/Rationale</u>: Provide context for the study, including the problem being addressed and the significance of the research.
- 3. <u>Methods</u>: Briefly describe the methodologies employed in the research, highlighting any novel techniques.
- 4. <u>Results:</u> Summarize the key findings of the study, providing data or insights that support the conclusions.
- 5. <u>Conclusions and Perspectives:</u> Discuss the implications of the findings and suggest potential directions for future research.

Please select a research stream when submitting your abstract, from the following categories: Translational Medicine, Systems Modeling and Data Analytics, Epidemiology and Disease Ecology, and Social Sciences and Medicine.

<u>All abstracts must be submitted by October 11, 2024.</u> Abstracts will be reviewed by the conference committee, and notifications of acceptance will be sent by October 25, 2024.
