

## Request for Proposals: Social Justice and the Socially Engaged Arts

July 15, 2022

The Office of the Provost is pleased to announce a new research funding program in the broad areas of social justice and the socially engaged arts. This opportunity, open to full-time faculty of any rank from all Emory, seeks proposals of compelling new ideas for research or scholarly works. Proposals can address work that aligns with a single topic area or work that integrates efforts across multiple areas and may request up to \$300,000 over a three-year period. Proposals must include a clear plan for using these seed funds to create a (mostly) self-sustaining signature initiative at Emory.

An ad hoc review committee comprising Emory faculty members will evaluate and review the proposals. This committee will recommend to the Office of the Provost leadership team those proposals that are sufficiently compelling and impactful to warrant central investment. Up to five projects will be funded.

Proposals are due in Emory's [InfoReady system](#) on October 15, 2022. Recipients will be notified of their award on December 1, 2022, and funds will be released on December 15, 2022.
