This session will explore how the WE ACT framework can be applied to healthcare delivery and serve as a practical tool for developing health-focused community solutions that reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The session will also touch on how extreme weather, such as extreme heat and flooding, can contribute to the spread of infectious diseases.
