



GEORGIA CTSA COVID – 19 BIOREPOSITORY

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The Georgia CTSA Clinical Research Center at Emory has established a COVID-19 Biorepository that includes residual nasopharyngeal (NP) swab samples from over 1,700 patients known to be COVID-19 positive and negative.

Our goal is to provide de-identified samples to investigators validating or developing diagnostics and therapeutics in an effort to improve the understanding of the effects, response, and mechanism of the SARS-CoV-2 virus and its variants.

Fee: \$50/sample

Requests will include the following data points/sample:

- Patient Age and Sex
- Assay type: Roche Diagnostics Cobas 6800
- Transport medium type
- Sample collection date/time
- PCR test date/time
- CT values
- Sample aliquot date
